Public notice is given to the electors of the District of Wells that nominations for the offices of one Mayor and four Councillors will be received by the Chief Election Officer, or a designated person, from 9:00 am Tuesday, September 1, 2026, to 4:00 pm Friday, September 11, 2026. Nominations will be received in the following ways:

Originals of emailed nomination documents must be received by the Chief Election Officer, or a designated person by 4:00 pm Friday, September 18, 2026, or the person nominated will be deemed to have been withdrawn as a candidate.

Nomination forms will be available as of August 4, 2026, from the Chief Election Officer, or a designated person, from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm, Monday to Friday, at the Wells District Office, 4243 Sanders Avenue and on the District of Wells website at wells.ca

Qualifications for Office

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

Canadian Citizen;

18 Years of Age on or before Saturday, October 17, 2026 (General Voting Day);

Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed;

Not disqualified by the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office.

Campaign Expense Limit

The Local Elections Campaign Financing Act stipulates the following 2026 campaign expense limits are \$12,635.576 for Mayor and \$6,317.79 for Councillor. Also, \$924.28 for advertising limits apply for third party advertising.
