VOTING REQUIREMENTS

Voters will register at the time of voting and must meet the following qualifications:

- Canadian Citizen,
- 18 years of age or older on voting day,
- Resident of BC for a least 6 months immediately preceding voting day,
- Resident of District of Wells at the time of voting, or registered owner of real property in the District of Wells, for 30 days immediately preceding voting day,
- Not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

ALL VOTERS are required to show two pieces of identification; the identification **MUST INCLUDE THEIR NAME AND RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS**. One of the pieces of identification **MUST ALSO INCLUDE THEIR SIGNATURE**. If neither piece of identification shows the elector's residential address, they must make a **SOLEMN DECLARATION** as to their place of residence.

ALL Non-Resident Property VOTERS must bring applicable identification as above and prove they are entitled to register to vote in relation to the property (i.e. 2026 Property Tax Notice) and **WRITTEN CONSENT** from a majority of the other property owners of the property.
