Re: Traffic Change and Improvements to Bowman Crescent

Attention: Residents of Bowman Crescent

Please be advised that at the Regular Council meeting of November 24th, 2020, Council Resolved the following:

MOVED Jordan Rohatynski, seconded Mandy Kilsby THAT Council approves the District implementing temporary parking restrictions to allow for parking on one side of the street and lanes of Bowman Crescent for the Winter of 2020/2021 which reflects the property owners within the lane/s being allowed to park directly in front of their properties on the left hand side of the laneway if you were travelling counter-clockwise around the Crescent and parking on the right hand side in front of their property on the Crescent (if travelling in a clockwise direction); and directs staff to implement children at play signage as well as 15km/hr maximum speed limits on the lanes and street of Bowman Crescent.

MOVED Jordan Rohatynski, Seconded Mandy Kilsby THAT Council tables the discussions and decisions to widen lanes on Bowman Crescent until Spring/Summer 2021 after further public consultation and staff research.

Carried Unanimously

MOVED Mandy Kilsby, Seconded Jordan Rohatynski THAT Council directs staff to encourage residents and community members to travel in one direction on Bowman Crescent, staying right in a counter-clockwise direction, entering the lane and travelling around the Crescent back to Pooley Street as per the Fire Chief's request and strong recommendations.

Residents are kindly reminded that there is no parking on the streets or laneways on Snow Removal Days (Wednesdays) as per the District of Wells Streets and Traffic Bylaw No. 170, 2018. Please ensure any tenants and/or visitors you may have are also aware of the above changes as well as the need for them to move their vehicles off the streets and lanes by 730am on Wednesdays to allow for snow clearing.
