Ice Rink Revitalization Project

In the fall of 2020 and in consultation with the community, user groups and the District of Wells the Community Facility Select Committee developed a business plan for the Wells-Barkerville Culture and Recreation Centre (interim name). The business plan is a living document that provides a vision of the future for the facility and green space, and a road map to get there. It also addresses deferred maintenance issues, health and safety concerns, and ideas to make the facility financially sustainable.

The ice rink was identified as an integral part of the green space and constructing a roof over the rink has long been a community goal. Upgrades to the skating rink, including a roof, were captured in Phase 2 and 3 of the project plan. Funding that was subsequently applied for was approved last February and the DOW will receive \$441,600 towards this project.

The Wells Community Facility Select Committee is now pleased to share with you the architectural and conceptual drawings for the proposed ice rink roof. We value input from the community as we work towards achieving the goals outlined in the business plan and encourage you to share with us your thoughts and ideas regarding this project.
